



Living on Campus....What **Not** to Bring.

Please refer to the Student Handbook for details on all housing policies!

- Pets (including aquarium pets)
- Halogen & kerosene lamps
- Decorative lights (unless UL certified)
- Extension cords (unless UL certified)
- Candles/incense
- Any items which create an open-flame
- Artificial holiday trees
- Hover boards or similar items
- Grills, gas or charcoal (prohibited from the decks, backyards, porches and driveways of all residence halls)
- Weapons (real or realistic), including pepper spray
- Alcohol/Drugs/Paraphernalia
- Cars*

The following UNOPENED items can be stored but NOT USED in on campus housing. There will be storage available in a classroom building for these containers once they have been opened:

- Spray cans that contain flammable vapors such as fixatives
- Any oil based media
- Spray paints
- Flammable liquids or gases, including paint thinners

^{*} First year resident students cannot bring <u>cars</u> to campus. However, first year resident may request a waiver under certain circumstances. Waivers are rarely granted.
