SUMMER COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

ADVENTURES IN DRAWING & PAINTING For children who love to draw and paint and want to develop their skills. Explore the principles of drawing and painting from observation and imagination. Learn value, gesture, contour lines, color, and composition using a range of materials. The study of artists and their artwork inspires creative expression. Each session offers new projects and different challenges to allow for returning students.

ANIMATION Learn about animation and all of its possibilities. Develop drawing techniques to tell stories with still and moving images, using a variety of approaches.

ART ALIVE! In this “live”-ly week of art-making, explore art from around the world that focuses on our favorite living things. People, animals of all kinds, and even our living environment that is full of nature’s finest creations! Enjoy exploring these living wonders through the eyes of living artists from Beverly to Bulgaria to London to Tokyo and beyond!

ART EXPLORERS Create eclectic 2-D and 3-D art collections using clay, wire, fabric, paint, and other materials.

ART-FULL PLAY Open channels of creativity, relax, and clear your mind through structured creative play. This playful class for adults and teens begins with the art of doodling to open up channels of creativity. Doodling can lead to fresh ideas for making deeply personal works of art. Students will be guided through the simple process with pen and paper, then, expand their experience by introducing other media.

ART, NATURE, AND THE ENVIRONMENT For centuries, artists have been influenced by nature. Take a closer look at the big and small marvels we get to experience every day, from tiny insects to mountain peaks. Use personal experiences and memories from journeys in the outside world to create mixed media paintings and collages that explore the unique connection between art and nature. Practice looking closely at the smaller, beautiful pieces of our world and use these observations to influence our drawings, paying attention to the color, textures, and patterns found in nature. Create our artwork mindfully and act as curious observers of the natural world throughout the week!

AUTHORS CLUB Become an author! Learn about story elements, narrative story writing, illustration, and create your very own hardback book.

CARTOONING AND COMICS WORKSHOP Create original cartoons using visual storytelling through scriptwriting, character development, and background design. A sequential storyboarding process leads students from initial sketches to the final printing of completed comic narratives. Use hand-drawn illustrative techniques to sketch, ink, color, write, and print finished comics.

COMIC BOOK ART Develop and expand a personal style of comic book art using dreams, superheroes, and the works of famous artists. Story, character development, and drawing techniques are addressed.

DRAWING AND CARTOONING Learn the tips and tricks of creating your own characters, scenes, and action-filled adventures while exploring

drawing basics including line, shape, and composition. Explore fantasy worlds, monsters, dragons, unicorns, fairies, and elves. Create a map of your fantasy world, and a flipbook animation, too. A fun-filled, imaginative class!

DRAWING Students develop their ability to look carefully at what they are drawing, to recognize relationships, and to develop their drawings.

IPHONEOGRAPHY (Smartphoneography) iPhoneography is the latest photography trend to hit full stride in the art world. It challenges photographers to take high-quality photos with their iPhone and to turn everyday moments into works of art. The iPhone allows photographers to take pictures of objects that they would usually pass by. They allow people to capture moments so that they may be turned into memories.

MIXED MEDIA Work with all kinds of media including collages, rocks, watercolors, acrylics, natural materials, mosaics, and more. This fun class teaches students to explore with all kinds of materials to create open art. It opens students up to new ways of being creative in general. Each student will complete a different project each day.

MONSTER MASH DRAWING Develop illustration skills using monsters as inspiration. Monsters, like our imaginations, follow no rules. They can have six eyes, two heads, five eyes, horns or wings. Don't worry about the rules and let your creativity take over! Build visual art skills and drawing techniques using a variety of materials such as graphite, ink pens, and colored pencils. Through demonstration and mark-making techniques, you'll learn how to break down each monster, bit-by-bit to build the monster of your dreams.

PAINTING Introduces a variety of painting techniques. Students produce exercises and finished canvases on a variety of subjects and are encouraged to create their own solutions and to choose subject matter. They will develop critical skills for evaluating their own work and that of others.

SCULPTING WITH NATURE This course will begin with an inspirational introduction to recognizable works of art, move towards construction techniques, and finally travel outside where students will be interacting with nature in its rawest form.

SKETCHBOOK & ILLUSTRATION Learn to express your ideas; find, explore, and develop your own style in a sketchbook filled with personal narratives. Play with shapes, expressive marks, drawing distortions, and other creative methods to transmute emotions into uplifting art.

T-SHIRT DESIGN Use fabric paint, tie-dye, and batik to design one of a kind creation. All students must provide five prewashed, 100% cotton t-shirts to decorate.

WONDROUS WATERCOLOR Paint outside the lines! Create realistic and experimental watercolors in this hands-on course. Learn a variety of techniques like splash, splatter, wash, wet-on-wet, and dry brush. We'll even experiment with salt. You'll also learn to incorporate plants and animals into your paintings with proper scaling, all the while, searching for inspiration through photographs, real life, and your imagination.
