

What to Bring

The substance free residences halls at Montserrat offer the independence of apartment-style living with a complete bath, kitchen and living room. All are furnished with beds, bureaus, closet or armoire, kitchen tables and chairs. Contact your roommates before purchasing any items, as this will avoid overcrowding in your apartment and could save you from moving unnecessary items in and out of your new home.

Furniture:

- lamps (non-halogen)
- clean sofa/chairs*
- desk*
- waste paper baskets

Kitchen needs:

- groceries and cooking supplies
- pots and pans
- coffee pot & toaster
- utensils
- cleaning supplies
- kitchen towels & pot holders

Bed & bath

- twin XL/long bed sheets
- personal toiletries
- toilet paper
- bath towels
- Shower curtain and rod
- pillows & cases
- blankets/comforter
- clothes hangers

Other

- flashlight & batteries
- first aid supplies
- plants
- drop cloths (to protect floors and furniture from projects)
- bicycle and bike lock*
- musical instruments*

* Students are allowed to bring bicycles. However, they must be stored on the bike racks and registered with Campus Security upon arrival. Students are allowed to bring most musical instruments, but are required to use a headset while using an

amplifier. Students are expected to be courteous to their neighbors and roommates and follow the noise ordinances set forth in the Student Handbook.

What Not to Bring

Please refer to the Student Handbook for details on all housing policies.

- pets (including aquarium pets)
- halogen lamps
- decorative lights (unless UL certified)
- extension cords (unless UL certified)
- artificial holiday trees
- hover boards or similar items
- candles/incense
- kerosene lamps
- any items which create an open-flame
- grills, gas or charcoal (prohibited from the decks, backyards, porches and driveways of all residence halls)
- weapons (real or realistic)
- Alcohol/Drugs/Paraphernalia
- cars*

* Freshmen resident students may not bring cars to campus. However, freshmen resident students may request a waiver under certain circumstances. Waivers are rarely granted. There are some art supplies that will be essential for you to have as artists but that can pose a safety risk within campus housing. The following UNOPENED items can be stored but NOT USED in on campus housing. There will be storage available in a classroom building for these containers once they have been opened:

- spray cans that contain flammable vapors such as fixatives
- any oil based media
- spray paints
- Flammable liquids or gases, including paint thinners
